


Guide: Connect to video call via Zoom

Before your video call

There are a few things you can do while you are waiting for your video call to begin. Here are a few tips on how to make the most of your video call.

- ✓ Find somewhere you can talk without interruption.
- ✓ Make sure you have an internet connection.
- ✓ Ideally, use headphones with a built-in microphone if you can.
- ✓ It is a good idea to place your phone or computer on a table in front of you.

Connect to the video call via mobile phone

You will need:

- ✓ an iPhone or Android phone
- ✓ internet connection or mobile connection


How to connect to your video call using your phone

1. You will be sent a text message or an email containing a link. Click the link.



2. Select *Download* and the app will be installed free of charge. (You can also download the Zoom app directly from the App Store (iPhone) or Google Play (Android)).


3. Re-open your text message and click the link again.




4. You will be directed to a waiting room.






- Once you have entered the meeting, you will need to fill in your name and click *Continue* if you are using an *iPhone*, or OK if you are using Android






- Select *I Agree*






7. Select *OK* to connect your camera (only on iPhone. If you are using Android, you can skip to step 11).



8. Choose *Join with video* (only on iPhone)



9. Select *OK* to connect your microphone (only on iPhone)




10. Zoom will ask if you want notifications. Select Reject if you do not want notifications. (Only on iPhone)




11. Select *Call using Internet Audio* for iPhone, or *Call over internet* for Android.






- ✓ computer with webcam

How to connect to your video call using your computer


1. Open the email containing the link to the video meeting. Click the link.




2. A white dialog box will open when you click the link. Click *Join from your browser* (if you are using Chrome, Firefox or Safari).




3. Enter your name and click *Join*




4. You will be directed to a waiting room.

5. Click *Join Audio* by computer, then *Join Audio*



6. If the video doesn't automatically start, click *Start video*.
